CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES WITH THE SONG "HALLOWEEN"

* LEVEL 1 - Ages 4-7 (Kinder & Lower Primary)

🕠 1. Listening & Vocabulary

Target words: witch, broom, pumpkin, ghost, spider, skeleton, monster, candy, trick, treat, moon, party.

Activities:

- ☐ Flashcards game: match word ↔ image.
- \blacksquare "I Spy Halloween" Teacher says: "I spy something orange and round!" \to Pumpkin!
- Sing & Point: while listening to the song, children point to the picture (pumpkin, broom, etc.).

Extension:

Create a Halloween wall mural — every child adds one element mentioned in the song.

* 2. Rhyme & Rhythm

Objective: Feel rhythm and recognize rhyming pairs.

Examples: feathers / Halloween, glowing / showing / flowing, fascination / occasion.

Activities:

- Gody percussion: clap, tap knees, and snap on every "Boo, boo, boo!".
- Magic Stick" Game: one student waves a wand and says a rhyming pair aloud group repeats rhythmically.

📏 3. Grammar & Sentence Building

Focus: Present continuous (are flying, are glowing, are streaming).

Activities:

- Mime verbs from the lyrics → "Witches are flying!" / "Ghosts are gleaming!"
- Match sentence halves:
- Spiders are... \rightarrow causing fascination
- Ghosts are... → gleaming everywhere





Objective: Encourage empathy, sharing, and joyful group participation. Questions:

- "What makes you happy on Halloween?"
- "What would you do if someone said Trick or Treat to you?"
- "How can we share candies politely?"

Activity:

Draw a face showing how you feel during Halloween: happy, excited, surprised, scared-but-funny.

🤔 5. Arts & Crafts

Ideas:

- * Spider webs: string and glue on black paper.
- See Pumpkin masks: orange paper plates with cut-out eyes.
- Ghost mobiles: tissue paper ghosts hanging from sticks.
- Magic broom craft: paper + popsicle stick + wool.

- Trick or Treat Parade: walk around the class singing the chorus.
- "Find the Pumpkin" Treasure Hunt: follow rhyming clues.
- Freeze Boo! dance to the music and freeze when the teacher shouts "Boo!"
