
# A Paper Boat

### Toninas (Franciscana Dolphins)

- What they are: Small dolphins, very playful and fast.
- Where they live: In the sea, close to the coast. In South America, from Brazil down to Uruguay and northern Argentina.
- What they look like: Dark gray color, short snout, and they love to jump over the waves.
- Fun fact: They are very sociable, often swimming in groups and sometimes following boats.

#### > Seals

- What they are: Marine mammals (just like us, they are mammals, not fish).
- Where they live: In cold places, such as Patagonia, Antarctica, and the Arctic.
- What they look like: They have chubby bodies, skin covered with short fur, and sensitive whiskers to detect fish.
- Fun fact: Although they look clumsy on land, in the water they are very fast and graceful.

### 

- What they are: The largest animals on the planet. They are also mammals.
- Where they live: In all the oceans. Some travel thousands of kilometers from polar waters to warmer areas to have their calves.
- What they look like: They breathe air through a blowhole on their head (the "spout" we see when water shoots out).
- Fun fact: In Argentina, at Península Valdés, you can see southern right whales. They are enormous and even leap out of the water!

#### Penguins

- What they are: Seabirds, but they cannot fly. Instead, they swim very fast underwater.
- Where they live: In cold places of the Southern Hemisphere, such as Patagonia, the Falkland Islands, and Antarctica.
- What they look like: They have black feathers on their back and white feathers on their belly, as if they were wearing a tuxedo.
- Fun fact: They waddle when they walk, which makes them move in a funny way. They live in huge colonies. Penguin parents take great care of their chicks.



- $\P$  Toninas  $\to$  Only in South America (Brazil, Uruguay, Argentina).
- $\blacktriangleright$  Seals  $\rightarrow$  In the Arctic (Canada, Norway, Russia) and also in Patagonia.
- ightharpoonup Whales ightharpoonup In all the oceans, both in the north and in the south.
- ♠ Penguins → Southern Hemisphere: Antarctica, Patagonia, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, and even in the Galápagos Islands (Ecuador).
